Please note the following:

- Entries should be on the standard calligraphy paper similar to A4 size with black ink, however, we will accept entries on white A4 paper (i.e. photocopier or art paper) or with black paint (watered to similar consistency as ink).
- A3 or ink of any other colour will not be accepted.
- Entries must be students own work and not traced or had teacher assistance.
- Students should write their own name (in katakana or kanji) vertically on the lower left hand edge on the front of the calligraphy (see attached example).
- Include a copy of the enclosed label with student name, year level, school, teacher name, email address and signed declaration on reverse of the calligraphy.
- The competition is open from when you receive this flyer notification.
- Please do not leave posting of entries until the last minute, we suggest using express post if you are sending close to the date.
